

Are you not getting your Golf Genius or valleygolfers.com emails? Suggest making these email addresses as contacts, saturday@valleygolfers.com, wednesday@valleygolfers.com, and web@valleygolfers.com. Make golfgenius.com and valleygolfers.com safe domains in your email program. Here is how in Gmail for example:

To add a domain as safe in Outlook, follow these steps:

1. **Open Outlook** and go to the **Home** tab.
2. In the **Delete** group, click the arrow next to **Junk**.
3. Select **Junk E-mail Options**.
4. In the **Junk Email Options** dialog box, go to the **Safe Senders** tab.
5. Click **Add**.
6. In the **Add address or domain** dialog box, enter the domain you want to add (e.g., @example.com).
7. [Click \*\*OK\*\* to save the changes<sup>12</sup>](#).

This will ensure that emails from the specified domain are not treated as junk and will go directly to your inbox.

1. **Open Gmail** and click on the gear icon in the top-right corner, then select **"See all settings."**
2. Go to the **"Filters and Blocked Addresses"** tab.
3. Click on **"Create a new filter."**
4. In the **"From"** field, enter the domain you want to whitelist. For example, if you want to whitelist all emails from example.com, enter @example.com.
5. Click on **"Create filter."**
6. Check the box next to **"Never send it to Spam."**
7. [Click on \*\*"Create filter"\*\* again to save your settings<sup>1</sup>](#)
